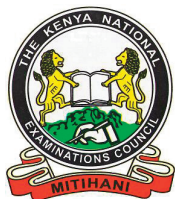

PRACTICAL INSTRUCTIONS

The information contained in this document is to enable the Principal and the Art teacher to make adequate preparations for this year's KCSE Art and Design practical examination.

*Candidates will be instructed to choose only **ONE** option from any one of the **two** alternatives **A** and **B**. However, the Art teacher **must** make provisions for **all the options** for the Candidates to make their choices. **All materials required for the examination MUST be issued to the candidates or placed at a central point before the start of the examination and NOT when in session.***

***NOTE:** The examination is treated as in progress from the time the candidates enter the room until all the scripts are collected. The Art teacher should **NOT** be within the precincts of the art room while the examination is in progress.*

*The question paper will be given to the candidates **one hour before the start of the examination** to enable them sketch their choices on **A4 size paper provided by KNEC in the examination room**. The **A4 sketches** must be handed in together with the final examination done on **A2 size paper** provided.*

*Candidates should be advised that use of coloured pencils, crayons, luminous pens or marker pens is **NOT ALLOWED** in any alternative. The use of tracing paper or geometrical instruments is **forbidden** in alternative A but allowed in alternative B.*

***NOTE:** The use of computers is strictly **NOT ALLOWED**.*

MATERIALS AND TOOLS REQUIRED FOR THE PRACTICAL EXAMINATION

(Schools to provide)

1.	Pencils B, HB, 2B, 3B, 6B range	Any 4 pieces	<i>Per candidate</i>
2.	Eraser	1 piece	<i>Per candidate</i>
3.	Water colour - tubes	Set of 24 assorted shades or 18 or 12 pieces per packet	<i>These can be shared amongst the Candidates.</i>
4.	Assorted sizes of paint brushes	5 pieces	<i>Per candidate</i>
5.	Poster colours	6 bottles 30 ml or 6 bottles 15 ml x 6	<i>The 30 ml bottles can be shared amongst the candidates.</i>
6.	Tracing paper	Size A4	<i>For alternative B only, 1 sheet per candidate</i>

DRAWING PAPER AND RETURN ENVELOPE (*Provided by the Kenya National Examinations Council*)

1. **A4-size plain paper** (*This comes packed as A3 paper sheet micro perforated to give 2 detachable A4 sheets*)

NOTE: Each candidate should be provided with A4-size plain paper to make preliminary sketches, **one hour** before the start of the examination to help them make their choices.

2. **A2-size drawing paper.**
3. **Return packaging manila envelope.**

NOTE:-Mounting of the candidates artwork is not part of the examination requirement.

- The examination must be done on the A2 drawing paper provided.
- No additional packaging material should be used; nothing should be stuck on the A2 manila return envelope, neither should the school name or code be written on it.

*The Principal should ensure that the **sticker bearing the school name and code** that come printed on the return manila envelope provided is **removed before it is returned to the distribution centre at the end of the examination.**
