**INSTRUCTIONS TO SCHOOLS**

1. The examination centres should ensure that materials for the project are available by **3<sup>rd</sup> May 2022**.
2. Good quality softwood may be used for the project.
3. The examination paper (project) should be issued to the candidates when the schools open but not later than **3<sup>rd</sup> May 2022**.
4. The teacher in charge of the subject should ensure that the projects are **completed** and **marked** by **31<sup>st</sup> July 2022 (Milestone 1)** and **31<sup>st</sup> October 2022 (Milestone 2)**. The subject teacher must ensure pictorial evidence of the candidates' performance on the project is sent to KNEC for the **two** stated milestones.
5. The candidates' project marks must be kept **confidential**.
6. The examination centres are advised to strictly adhere to the KNEC dates for completion and assessment of the projects. Schools which do not comply will have their candidates' project marks entered as **incomplete** and thus affecting their final subject grade for woodwork.
7. The schools **must** ensure that all the candidates' projects are not disposed off until **three months** after the KCSE results are released.
