A pattern of a girl's skirt is provided. You are advised to study the sketches, instructions and layout carefully before you begin the test.

**Materials provided.**

1. **Pattern pieces.**
  - A - Skirt back
  - B - Skirt front
  - C - Pocket
  - D - Waistband
2. Plain light weight cotton fabric 55cm × 90cm wide.
3. Sewing thread to match the fabric.
4. One large envelope.

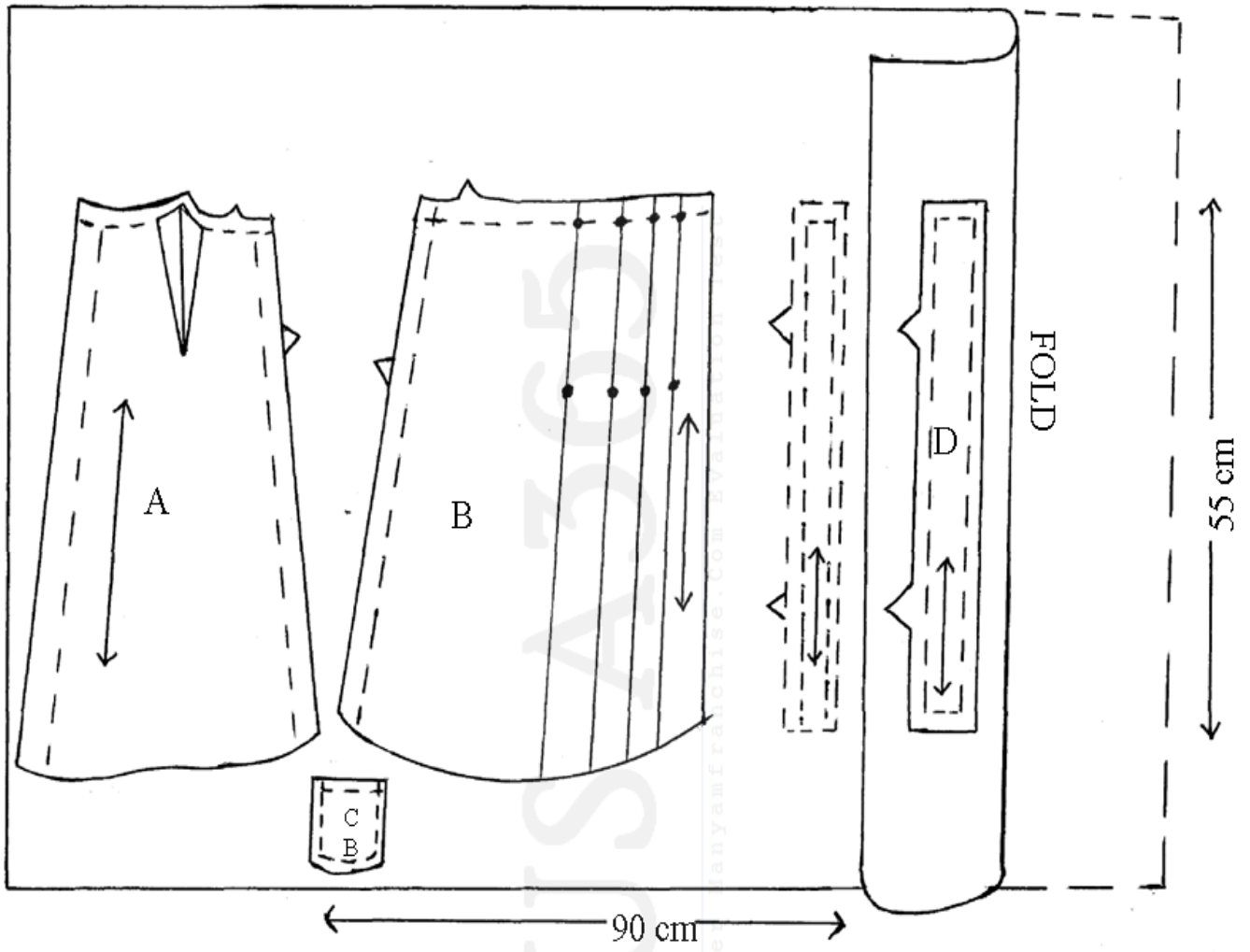
**THE TEST**

Using the materials provided, cut out and make the RIGHT HALF of the skirt to show the following processes.

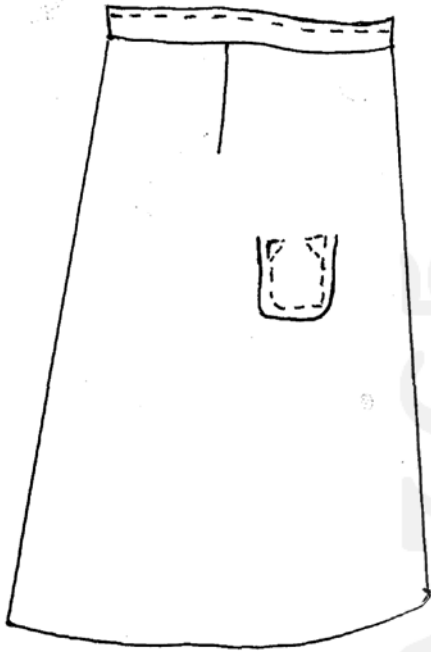
- (a) Making of the back dart.
- (b) Preparation of the patch pocket and attaching it into the back skirt.
- (c) Preparation of pleats on the skirt front.
- (d) Making of the skirt seam using an open seam neaten it by edge stitching
- (e) Preparation of an interfaced, waistband
- (f) Attachment of the waistband, slip-hem the
- (g) Using stem stitch, embroider the letter b on the pocket

At the end of the examination, firmly sew onto your work, on single fabric, a label bearing your name and Index number. Remove needles and pins from your work, fold your work neatly and place it in the envelope provided. Do not put scraps of fabric in the envelope.

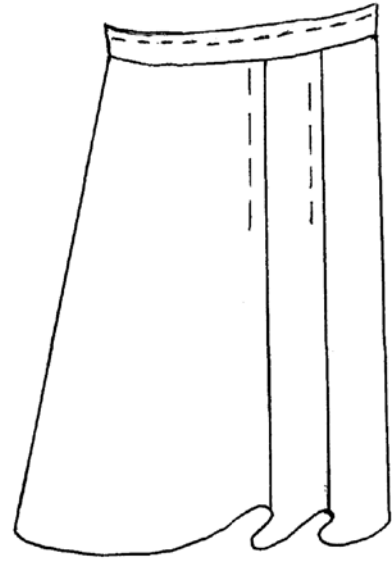
**THE LAYOUT (NOT DRAWN TO SCALE)**
