



5. Below is a map showing the Great Lakes of North America and River St. Lawrence. Use it to answer the questions that follow.




- a) Name the following :



 e) State three ways in which high population density has physically affected the Kenya highlands. (3 marks)


9. Below is a map of Kenya showing selected urban centres. Use it to answer the questions which follow.
