- (b) Explain what the teaching of Jesus about the vine and the branches in John 15:1-10 reveal about the unity of believers. (8 marks)
- (c) Give **seven** ways in which Christians prevent divisions in the church in Kenya today. (7 marks)
5. (a) Explain the factors that contribute to unemployment in Kenya today. (8 marks)
- (b) Give **eight** causes of conflict between the employer and employees in Kenya. (8 marks)
- (c) Discuss the role of a Christian during a strike. (4 marks)
6. (a) Give **six** reasons why it is important to have laws in a country. (6 marks)
- (b) Outline **eight** problems related to maintenance of law and order in Kenya today. (8 marks)
