What is a DBMS?

A database management system (DBMS) is an application software that lets the computer user to create, manage, retrieve and manipulate data in a database.

Functions of a database management system

1. Allow users to delete or add records
2. Update and modify existing records
3. Organize data for easy access, retrieval and manipulation of records
4. Ensuring the security of data
5. Keep statistics of data in the database.
6. Producing reports
7. Store data in tables
